BHS Graduation

BCS Eighth Grade Promotion

“Grab n’ Go” Meals

We will continue to offer breakfast and lunch “Grab n’ Go” meals until the end of the school year. This is available to any Bolton family with children up to age 18. We serve two (2) breakfast and lunch meals on Mondays, two (2) breakfast and lunch meals on Wednesdays, and three (3) breakfast and lunch meals on Fridays at Bolton High School between 8:00 – 9:00 AM. Please be sure to follow the following protocol:

1. Line up in cars on the side of Bolton High School next to the cafeteria.
2. Please **Do Not Leave** your vehicle or enter the building.
3. Tell us how many children in your care that need meals.
4. Wait in vehicle until staff brings out the meals and places them on a table.
5. Staff **will walk away and you can leave your vehicle to pick up the meals on the table and return to your car.**
